6. I undertake not to remove my face mask during. the duration of IDO World Championships WARSAW`2021, before its commencement and after its end, until departure from the hotel premises.
7. I undertake to comply with the internal regulations of the IDO World Championships WARSAW`2021 organizers related to the prevention, prevention and control of COVID-19 and other infectious diseases, including I agree to measure the temperature before entering the audience, backstage and recording it by the Organizer's staff.
8. Being aware of the state of the COVID-19 epidemic in force in Poland, I voluntarily and consciously participate in the IDO World Championships WARSAW`2021 at the SANGATE HOTEL

Personal data will be processed in order to perform tasks related to counteracting COVID-19, pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. d, art. 9 sec. 2 lit. f and art. 9 section 2 lit. and GDPR, as well as in connection with the Act of March 2, 2020 on special solutions related to the prevention, counteracting and combating COVID-19, other infectious diseases and the crisis situations caused by them (Journal of Laws 2020, item 374).

3. We will process the data for 6 years - in connection with the investigation and defense against claims regarding the services provided.

4. We will transfer your personal data only to entities authorized by law.

5. You have the following rights related to the processing of personal data:

- a) The right to access your personal data,
- b) The right to request the rectification of your personal data
- c) The right to request the deletion of your personal data only if we are not required by law to process them.

To exercise the rights of the above-mentioned contact us in the manner set out in point 1, points a, b, c. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data, the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

6. Your data will not be transferred to third countries, nor will it be subject to automated decision making or profiling.

Providing these data is obligatory for reasons related to the public interest in the field of public health in order to protect against health threats, in this case related to the prevention and combating of SARS-CoV-2 infection and the spread of COVID-19 infectious disease in humans, caused by SARS-CoV-2 virus.
