

IDO WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS – POLAND, December 21

Your safety is our priority!

Health and safety of dancers, instructors, employees, associates and partners are among our top priorities, and activities in this area are constantly updated based on information provided by the government of the Republic of Poland. The compliance with the recommendations resulting from this document is supervised by Organizers of IDO WC and trainers / supervisors of clubs - dance schools.

When arriving in Poland, you must have a EU COVID certificate (Covid passport) or a certificate with a negative antigen test or PCR with you. If you report such a need, we will provide you with the opportunity to take the test before returning home in the district. The cost of such a test is 35 EURO.

For the safety of stay, i.e. accommodation, moving around the facility and food is provided by Hotel SANGATE Airport*** in Warsaw in detail described in a special brochure issued by the Hotel, which is incorporated herein by reference document. Check what we do additionally to make it even safer!

1 Automatic temperature measurement

Just like we test our employees, we also measure the temperature of the participants of the IDO World Championships Warsaw`2021 and the judges. Each participant of the Championships will have the temperature measured. Cameras will also support us and thermal imaging gates that perform measurements automatically and, in the event of an anomaly, send information to the organizer of the Championship. Cameras will be placed in sensitive points in the Hotel, yes that every person coming and going from the audience has their body temperature measured.



2 Protective masks, disinfectants and information posters

Whenever this safety report mentions other safeguards, the obligation to wear protective masks during the entire stay at the hotel and multiple hand disinfection should be added to them. For this purpose, there are 30 containers with disinfectant throughout the hotel. Liquids are also placed in the toilets. There are also posters throughout the hotel reminding you of the COVID-19 recommendations.

Logistics for announcing results and awarding prizes

The results will be announced only by announcing them by the moderator, without the participation of the dancers. Diplomas, cups and medals will be collected by the National Team Captain from the special preparing place. The Receipt will be confirmed with a handwritten signature

Limited number of people in the audience

To enter the audience, download the STATEMENT + GDPR documents from the website www.worlddanceweek.com , print them, fill them in and hand them over to the Organizer before entering the audience.

Without making statements, entering the audience is impossible.

Tickets will be prepared in online pre-sale. If there are any available tickets, they can be purchased at the competition box office. Only 50% of the seats (including coaches and guardians, but not including spectators with “Covid passport”) may be occupied.

We organize the Championships in such a way that everyone can see them, but at the same time the number of spectators remained within the established limits. Every second armchair or chair should be occupied maintaining a safe social distance.

A livestream will be prepared for the rest of the people. Information about livestream you can find at www.worlddanceweek.com

During the entire time in the audience, it is obligatory to maintain social distance and wear protective masks or helmets. Eating and drinking is not allowed.

The participant of the event / event in a closed room is obliged to submit a written statement upon entering the event that the participant, to the best of his knowledge, is not an infected person and is not in quarantine or under epidemiological supervision.

The participant is obliged to include contact details (telephone number) in the declaration, which will enable easy contact with him after the end of the event / event in a situation where the sanitary services determine that the infected person participated in the event and will conduct an epidemiological investigation.

Safe staff

We allow to work only those people who, have negative antigen test or “covid passport” before the start of each day of the championships, have passed an internal safety control consisting of an interview with the competition office and measurement of their body temperature. The staff actively monitors compliance with the epidemic safety rules, and the Organizers of the Championship are responsible for the area of proceeding in connection with the COVID-19 epidemic stand.

6 Organization of the Championship

You should arrive at the competition at fixed times so as not to form clusters. The championship plan will be prepared in such a way that the final dancers will not meet those who have just arrived for the competition. Only healthy people, without symptoms, who have not lived with a person staying in quarantine or isolation at home during the last 14 days before the beginning of the classes, may participate in the Championship. Persons who are not coaches / guardians or organizers of the championship are strictly forbidden in the dancers zone.

7 Safety zones for participants.

There are several dressing rooms in the hotel that will be made available for groups before the start. They will be marked and disinfected each day. The 1st floor, which is reserved for the Championship, will be a remote competition zone, to which only competitors, coaches, judges, organizing team and spectators with purchased tickets will have access.

8 Isolatory

The hotel has a designated room for people with symptoms or suspected infection. The isolation room was equipped with protective agents and disinfecting liquid.

9 Information

COVID-19. Information posters were displayed in the premises in accordance with the guidelines of the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate on limiting the spread of COVID-19 and maintaining proper hand hygiene. Hand disinfection places have also been marked, and at the reception desk there is a list of emergency telephone numbers, including those to the nearest sanitary and epidemiological station.

10 Dedicated paramedic / nurse

Qualified paramedics will be available on site throughout the duration of the championship to provide the first line of medical support in the event of an emergency. In serious cases, it will provide the necessary support until the ambulance arrives.
