**COUCIL OF MINISTERS' DECREE**  
**of 19 March 2021**

on the establishment of certain restrictions, orders and bans in connection with an epidemic Based on Article. 46a and art. 46b points 1-6 and 8-13 of the Act of 5 December 2008 on preventing and combating human infections and infectious diseases (Journal of Laws of 2020, items 1845, 2112 and 2401 and of 2021 pos. 159, 180 and 255) it is ordered as follows:

Chapter 2, Paragraph 2

point 2:

take, after crossing the state border, compulsory quarantine, referred to in the regulations issued on the basis of art. 34 sec. 5 of the Act of 5 December 2008 on the prevention and combating of infections and infectious diseases in humans, lasting 10 days, counting from the day following the crossing of this border.

point 18:

Until April 9, 2021, the obligation to undergo quarantine, referred to in the regulations issued on the basis of art. 34 sec. 5 of the Act of 5 December 2008 on preventing and combating infections and infectious diseases in humans, lasting 10 days from the day following the crossing of the state border of the Republic of Poland, also applies to persons crossing the state border, which is an internal border within the meaning of Art. . 2 point 1 of Regulation (EU) 2016/399 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on the EU Code on the rules governing the movement of persons across borders (Schengen Borders Code)

**EXCLUSIONS:**

Chapter 2, Section 3.2

The obligation referred to in § 2 para. 2 and 18, shall not apply in the case of crossing the border of the Republic of Poland/

point 12:

by persons participating as a competitor, member of the training staff, doctor, physiotherapist or referee, in international sports competitions organized on the territory of the Republic of Poland by an international sports federation operating in Olympic or Paralympic sports or other recognized by the International Olympic Committee or organized by an international sports organization with a continental range belonging to such a federation or a Polish sports association, as well as by accredited journalists;

point 17:

by members of the national team of Polish sports associations, members of the training staff, doctors, physiotherapists and sports referees, returning to the Republic of Poland from foreign training camps or from international competitions organized by an international sports federation operating in Olympic or Paralympic sports or another recognized by the International Olympic Committee, or organized by a continental international sports organization belonging to such a federation;
